

The entire fourth floor is the master suite and includes a shiplap barn door that hides the second washer and dryer, remote controlled skylights to increase natural light, a private balcony overlooking the ocean, and a custom triangle dresser built into the roofline. The bathroom even has a towel warming drawer.

A separate kitchenette for guests includes bold, beachy turquoise appliances by Elmira Stove Works, giving it a California retro vibe. Guest suites offer custom bunk beds with full beds on the bottom, twins on top, and trundles underneath - sleeping 10 total.

A built-in window seat, a small, but mighty powder room featuring floor-to-ceiling fish-scale tiles, pet-friendly elements including a dog shower and custom pet gate, and honeycomb cement tiles on the ground floor bathroom round out a long list of colorful coastal elements making this a one-of-a-kind home.
